



**Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (“DBE”)
Stakeholder Meeting

The Massachusetts Port Authority (“Massport”), which owns and operates Boston Logan International Airport, Worcester Regional Airport and Laurence G. Hanscom Field, is required to submit to the Federal Aviation Administration overall goals for participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) in federally-assisted projects.

Massport’s proposed overall goal for DBE participation for Federal Fiscal Years 2020, 2021 and 2022 (October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2022) at Boston-Logan International Airport is 14.9%, Worcester Regional Airport is 15.2% and Laurence G. Hanscom Field is 14.0%.

Interested parties are invited to attend a stakeholder meeting to review the proposed goal and methodology and to provide any information that may assist in the development of the final DBE goals for Boston Logan International Airport, Worcester Regional Airport and Laurence G. Hanscom Field.
