

LIST OF ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS FOR SIDA/PSID BADGES

- Every badge applicant must present two forms of valid, unexpired acceptable documents.
- Proof of lawful status must be submitted with all applications.
- The documents marked with an asterisk are accepted as proof of lawful status.
- The applicant's legal name on all documents must match exactly.

List A

1. US Passport or US Passport Card*
2. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form-I-551)*
3. Foreign Passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa*
4. Employment Authorization document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)*
5. For a nonimmigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer because of his or her status:
 - a. Foreign Passport; and
 - b. Form I-94 or Form I-94A that has the following:
 - (1) The same name as the passport; and
 - (2) An endorsement of the alien's nonimmigrant status as long as that period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form.*
6. Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94A indicating nonimmigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association Between the United States and the FSM or RMI*

List B

1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a State or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
2. ID card issued by Federal, State or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
3. Voter's registration card
4. U.S. Military card or draft record
5. Military dependent's ID card
6. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
7. Native American tribal document
8. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority

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List C

1. A Social Security Account Number card unless the card includes one of the following restrictions:
 - (1) NOT VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT
 - (2) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH INS AUTHORIZATION
 - (3) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH DHS AUTHORIZATION
2. Certification of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545)*
3. Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State (Form DS-1350)*
4. Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a State, county, municipal authority, or territory of the United States bearing an official seal*
5. Native American tribal document
6. U.S. Citizen ID Card (USCIS Form I-197)
7. Identification Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)
8. Employment authorization document issued by the DHS



Minimum age required to apply for a PSID badge is 16 years of age.

Minimum age required to apply for a SIDA badge is 17 years of age.

Minimum age required to apply for a SIDA badge with driving privileges on the ramp is 18 years of age.

Each applicant must submit two forms of Identification, one of which must be proof of lawful status.

The documents that are highlighted on Page 1 are accepted as proof of lawful status.

Copies of the identification being used must be submitted with the badge application.

Originals must be shown at time of fingerprinting **and** badging. All IDs must be valid and unexpired at the time of badging

- **If the applicant was born in the United States or US Territory:** One of the documents must be a US Passport, US Passport Card or original or certified copy of a US birth certificate. Birth certificates issued by Puerto Rico prior to 07/01/2010 are not acceptable.
- **If the applicant was born outside the United States and is now a US Citizen:** One of the documents must be a US Passport, US Passport Card, DS1350, or FS545.
- **If applicant is not a US Citizen:** Documents must establish lawful status and work authorization in the United States. Badge expiration will be determined by expiration of lawful status, expiration of work authorization, or expiration of contract (whichever is sooner).
- **One document must be a photo ID**
- **If driving privileges are requested, movement or non-movement,** a valid driver's license must be one of the documents. Driver's License must be updated when renewed. If a Driver's License expires on a SIDA Badge with Driving Privileges, the badge will be suspended until new license information is received.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Names on badge applications must match the names presented on the required documents and must be the full legal name of the applicant. Names on all submitted documents must match exactly.**
- All name changes must be accompanied by legal documents verifying the new name (legal name change form, marriage/divorce certificates etc.) All documents must reflect new names within 12 months of name change. Example of a scenario when the names on the IDs will not match; the name on a birth certificate and driver's license do not match due to marriage. A marriage certificate would be required in this scenario.
- Passports and Social Security cards are not valid unless signed by the applicant.
- If the applicant is not a US citizen, while on the job, the applicant must carry their valid documents allowing them to work (Employment Authorization card, Resident Alien card etc.) Audits are conducted on a regular basis to verify this information.
