

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND PUBLIC MEETING  
FOR L.G. HANSCOM FIELD, AVIATION FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Massachusetts Port Authority (Massport) has identified two areas for future, third-party development of general aviation and corporate facilities. The North Airfield Area is being considered for approximately 110,000 square feet of new hangar space, and 55,000 square feet of replacement T-Hangar space. A new taxiway would be constructed by Massport in order to provide access to these aviation facilities. The Pine Hill Area is also being considered for approximately 60,000 square feet of hangar development.

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Massport has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) for review by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to disclose the environmental impacts of the proposed action.
