TO: All Subscribers of the Massachusetts Port Authority Container Tariff No. 1 and Valued Customers

The Board of Massachusetts Port Authority voted to increase rates in its **Container Tariff No. 1**, which applies to the Paul W. Conley Container Terminal. The rate changes are **effective October 1**, 2022.

The charges in Container Tariff No. 1 have increased approximately 3%. These rate increases will offset the increased fringe benefit costs associated with the ILA master collective bargaining agreement. The rate increases will also assist in financing the critical Conley capital projects for crane, berth, and yard equipment upgrades, enabling Conley to service the big ships, which are now calling the east coast ports. The rates were last increased October 2021.

Further, the formatting in Container Tariff No. 1 has been updated and the schedule of fees can be found at the end of the document for easy access.
