


Aerial View of the Project Location







Existing Conditions – Aerial View Facing Northeast





ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS:

- No-Build option with minor seawall maintenance
- Sloped stone revetment
- Sheet pile bulkhead with reinforced concrete cap



PROPOSED PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE:

- Replace existing granite block/concrete vertical seawall between Piers 1 and 3 with sloped stone revetment.
- Demolish small timber pile-supported pier at west end of seawall adjacent to Pier 1.
- Construct cut-off wall and 6 ft. high fence at north end of Pier 3 to prevent public from accessing Pier 3.
- Complete unfinished waterfront of recently completed Piers Park II.
- Intend to dispose of dredge material in USACE Boston Harbor CAD Cell.




Aerial View of Existing Site Conditions






Preferred Alternative – Sloped Stone Revetment



PLAN PROPOSED SLOPED STONE REVETMENT




Preferred Alternative - Cross Section A




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Preferred Alternative – Cross Section B




Preferred Alternative – Cross Section C
