
L.G. Hanscom Field FY 2026 and FY 2027 Airfield Capital Improvement Projects *Project Briefing*

Projects included in RFQ:

- Rehabilitate Taxiway E from Runway 29 to Runway 5-23 with connection to Taxiway E1
- 2. Rehabilitate Taxiway R full length outside of runway safety areas
- 3. Rehabilitate Taxiway M from Runway 5 to Runway 11 with geometry improvements
- 4. Rehabilitate and Improvements to Geometry on Taxiway M South of Runway 5 to Taxiway S





Rehabilitate Taxiway E from Runway 29 to Runway 5-23 with Connection to Taxiway E1

- Taxiway E is a key taxi route that services Runway 11-29 and provides access to all major points on the terminal side of the airport. Project limits would extend from Runway 29 to Runway 5-23.
- Taxiway connection at Runway 29 would need to be reviewed for potential realignment with no major pavement modifications/relocations.
- Project includes new airfield lighting cable and upgrading all fixtures within work limits to LED.
- Project phasing will be critical due to its access and role as main taxi route for the airfield.
- Anticipated Project Schedule: Design FY26 (Fall 2025); Construction FY26/FY27 (FY26 runs 7/1/25 - 6/30/26)
- Anticipated Construction Cost: \$5 million





Rehabilitate Taxiway R Full Length outside of Runway Safety Areas



- Taxiway R is a key taxi route on the northern side of the airfield.
- Project limits would extend from the safety area of Runway 11 to the safety area of Runway 23.
- Alignment of taxiway within project limits to be reviewed for conformance with current FAA criteria.
- All lighting on Taxiway R will be upgraded to LED.
- Project phasing will be critical due to its access and role as main taxi route on northern side of airfield
- Anticipated Project Schedule: Design FY26 (Fall 2025); Construction FY27
- Anticipated Construction Cost: \$2.3 million



Rehabilitate Taxiway M from Runway 5 to Runway 11 with Geometry Improvements

- This project rehabilitates the northern portion of Taxiway M. Project limits would extend from Runway 5 to Runway 11.
- Geometry improvements at the TW M/TW E intersection and TW M/RW11 and TW M/RW5 intersections will be incorporated into this project.
- Project includes new airfield lighting cable and upgrading all fixtures within work limits to LED.
- Project phasing will be critical due to its proximity to airfield tenants and Fixed Base Operators (FBOs).
- Anticipated Project Schedule: Design FY26-FY27 (Fall 2025); Construction FY27
- Anticipated Construction Cost: \$2.5 million





Rehabilitate and Improvements to Geometry on Taxiway M South of Runway 5 to Taxiway S

- This project rehabilitates the southern portion of Taxiway M. Project limits would extend from Runway 5 to Taxiway S.
- Geometry improvements at the entrance to Runway 5 will be incorporated into this project.
- Project includes new airfield lighting cable and upgrading all fixtures within work limits to LED.
- Project phasing will be critical due to its proximity to airfield tenants and Fixed Base Operators (FBOs).
- Anticipated Project Schedule: Design FY26-FY27 (Fall 2025); Construction FY27
- Anticipated Construction Cost: \$1.5 million





Overall Project Scope of Work

- Consultant shall demonstrate experience in several disciplines including but not limited to:
 - Airfield civil/Civil 3D/CIM
 - Airfield pavement design
 - \circ Airfield electrical
 - Airfield construction phasing
 - Subsurface investigation and construction acceptance testing
 - Construction cost estimating
 - LEAN practices
 - Resident Inspection
 - Sustainable design,
 - o Climate Resiliency, and
 - LSP services as applicable





Scope of Work for each individual project listed in RFQ

Scope shall include but not be limited to:

- Review existing conditions and record information, prepare PDR in accordance with FAA guidelines.
- Assist with any necessary permitting, in particular with relation to NHESP as appropriate by project.
- Develop design documents suitable for bidding and construction including a Construction Safety and Phasing Plan.
- Construction Administration Services and full-time resident inspection services for all aspects of construction
- Acceptance testing throughout construction and managing the closeout process
- Develop detailed phasing plans for review.
- LSP services as needed to evaluate environmental conditions within work area.





Evaluation Criteria

The submission shall be evaluated on the basis of the following equally weighted criteria:

- (1) Experience and knowledge of the team for similar projects of similar size and complexity particularly important to demonstrate for the proposed Project Manager. Highlight experience and expertise for major sub-consultants and their assigned staff. Familiarity with public construction procurement under MGL Ch. 30 and demonstrated ability to design to FAA specifications and requirements.
- (2) Project understanding and proposed technical approach for each project the firm would like to apply for, including QA/QC process during document preparation, cost management and scheduling capabilities, construction oversight, ability to plan and perform work with minimal disruption to airport operations.
- (3) Demonstrated experience in integrating and managing CIM in the planning, design and construction. Experience of utilizing Lean Design & Construction (Last Planner System[®], Scrum or other tools) to increase reliability and significantly improve projects and teams' performance,
- (4) Demonstrated project experience in sustainable and resilient airfield and infrastructure design and construction including infrastructure sustainability certification schemes relevant to this proposal and in accordance with FAA guidelines, and
- (5) Proposed approach to enhance diversity and inclusion of the project teams to increase the pool of consultants working on the Authority's projects. For the DBE firms proposed, describe the type and/or category of work, include their specific role, and extent of their planned involvement.




