Additions and Deletions to RFQ

1. Summary of Question: Please provide clarity on DCAMM Certification and "Update Statement"

4. <u>Summary of Question</u>: Would the Authority consider separating the scope of work into two contracts, e.g. one for the Passenger Boarding Bridge scope and a separate contract for the Baggage Handling systems scope?

5. <u>Summary of Question</u>: Will the submittal requirements change to reflect an O&M contract rather than an installation or construction project?

6. <u>Summary of Question</u>: Schedule E- Legal Proceedings: Do we understand correctly that this question requires the contractor to list only those legal proceedings, arbitrations, etc. that are related to a specific project, and where the matter concluded adversely against our company?

<u>Response</u>: Schedule E – Legal Proceedings requires each Proposer to submit "A list of all legal or administrative proceedings currently pending against the general contractor or concluded adversely to the general contractor within the past 5 years which relate to the procurement or performance of any public or private construction contract."

7. <u>Summary of Question</u>: Please clarify if a General Contractor's license is required to carry out the works under this RFQ.
